ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN CASTLE PEAK ROAD, TSAP FAI STREET AND FUK WING STREET CHEUNG SHA WAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 9.00 a.m. on 20 December 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Castle Peak Road from a point about 25 metres west of its junction with Tsap Fai Street to a point about 47 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Castle Peak Road from a point about 15 metres west of its junction with Fuk Wing Street to its junction with Un Chau Street;
- (c) the section of Tsap Fai Street from its junction with Castle Peak Road to a point about 5 metres north of the same junction;
- (d) the eastern kerbside lane of Fuk Wing Street from its junction with Castle Peak Road to a point about 12 metres south of the same junction; and
- (e) the western kerbside lane of Fuk Wing Street from its junction with Castle Peak Road to a point about 22 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
