

SMALL UNMANNED AIRCRAFT ORDER

DESIGNATION OF RESTRICTED FLYING ZONE NOTICE

(Made under section 19(1) of the Small Unmanned Aircraft Order (Chapter 448G))

By virtue of the authority under section 19(1) of the Small Unmanned Aircraft Order, Chapter 448G, I hereby designate the area (including the airspace above the area) bounded by the following coordinates (WGS 84 Datum) as a restricted flying zone for the purposes of section 18(1) of the said Order:—

- 22°21'25"N 114°06'25"E
- 22°21'25"N 114°14'42"E
- 22°15'25"N 114°14'42"E
- 22°15'25"N 114°06'25"E

The designation made in this notice shall come into effect between 09.30 a.m. and 12.30 p.m. on 16 December 2023.

Pursuant to section 19 of the said Order, the Director-General of Civil Aviation, the Commissioner of Police, and the Secretary for Security may, by notice published in the Gazette, designate an area in Hong Kong (including the airspace above the area) as a restricted flying zone for the purposes of section 18(1) of the said Order. Furthermore, relevant officials may publish a notice in the Electronic Portal for Small Unmanned Aircraft ("eSUA"), the designated information system, if the officials consider that it is necessary to publish the notice as soon as practicable, and it is impracticable in the circumstances to publish the notice in the *Gazette*.

The above-mentioned restricted flying zone is shown as indexed, *inter alia*, on the Drone Map deposited in the library at the Civil Aviation Department Headquarters, 1 Tung Fai Road, Hong Kong International Airport, Lantau, Hong Kong. Members of public may also refer to the Drone Map on eSUA (<https://esua.cad.gov.hk/web/>) for all restricted flying zones designated by virtue of section 19.
