MEDICAL REGISTRATION ORDINANCE (Chapter 161)

ORDER MADE BY THE MEDICAL COUNCIL OF HONG KONG

The Medical Council of Hong Kong ('the Council') at a meeting held on 1 November 2023, being satisfied that Dr NG Kim Yee Naomi ('Dr NG') is, by reason of health, mentally unfit to practise medicine, surgery or midwifery, and in exercise of its power under section 21A(1) of the Medical Registration Ordinance, Chapter 161 of Laws of Hong Kong, ordered that the name of Dr NG be removed from the General Register for a period up to 30 November 2023 or the expiry of her provisional registration, whichever the later. The operation of the removal order be suspended on the conditions that:—

- (a) Dr NG shall in the meantime continue to receive treatment from her psychiatrist; and
- (b) Dr NG shall submit to the Health Committee an updated medical report from her psychiatrist by 15 November 2023 detailing her mental condition and clinical progress.

In accepting the recommendation of the Health Committee that Dr NG is mentally unfit to practise medicine, surgery or midwifery, the Council endorsed the view of the Health Committee that Dr NG's anxiety disorder, though currently in remission, may be expected to cause recurrence of impairment of fitness to practise medicine, surgery or midwifery.

In accordance with section 21A(2) of the said Ordinance, the above order shall be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette.
