

ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (Chapter 370)

(FORMERLY KNOWN AS ‘PWP ITEM NO. 7259RS (PART)—
CYCLE TRACKS CONNECTING NORTH WEST NEW TERRITORIES WITH
NORTH EAST NEW TERRITORIES—SECTION FROM TUEN MUN TO
SHEUNG SHUI’)

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has ordered under section 17(1)(a) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) (‘the Ordinance’) to close temporarily sections of the existing roads, footpaths/staircases, cycle tracks and tracks within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. NTN2218 (except limit of works area of part of the proposed cycle track shown on the Plan) and NTN2219 (except limit of works area from chainage CH-MP0+000m to CH-MP1+000m and from chainage CH-MP1+110m to CH-MP1+800m shown on the Plan) (‘the Plans’) and described in the scheme annexed thereto. The Plans and scheme were referred to in G.N. 3720 published on 6 June 2008 and 13 June 2008. The Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance that from 30 December 2021 to 29 December 2022, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the existing roads, footpaths/staircases, cycle tracks and tracks to be temporarily closed, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be, during that period.

The works to be carried out in association with this closure mainly involve the construction of facilities associated with the cycle tracks along Kam Tin River, Sheung Yue River and Shek Sheung River; construction of entry/exit hubs; and ancillary works including water, drainage, sewerage, geotechnical and landscaping works, construction of retaining structures and installation of traffic aids.

This notice will be affixed on or near the affected roads, footpaths/staircases, cycle tracks and tracks on 17 December 2021.

Any person entitled to compensation under the Ordinance may serve upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing a written claim, which can be submitted via one of the following means, before the expiration of one year from the date of closure, extinction, modification or restriction:—
