

PUBLIC ORDER ORDINANCE (Chapter 245)

CLOSED AREA—PERMISSION TO ENTER

Pursuant to section 38A(1) of the Public Order Ordinance and without prejudice to the provisions of any other Ordinance, persons within the category specified in the second column of the below Schedule are, for the purposes of the Public Order Ordinance, permitted to enter or leave the polling stations inside the Frontier Closed Area and Heung Yuen Wai Boundary Control Point as specified in the second column, during the dates and times specified in the third column of the Schedule, subject to the conditions specified in the fourth column of the Schedule.

In this notice, 'the Frontier Closed Area' refers to the area specified in the Schedule to the Frontier Closed Area Order (Chapter 245A); and 'Heung Yuen Wai Boundary Control Point' refers to the area specified in the Schedule to the Closed Area (Heung Yuen Wai Boundary Control Point) Order (Chapter 245N).

1.	Persons having successfully registered to vote in the 2021 Legislative Council General Election at polling stations in Lok Ma Chau Spur Line, Lo Wu or Heung Yuen Wai Boundary Control Point.	On Sunday 19 December 2021 between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 10.30 p.m.	(a) Persons must be eligible electors who have successfully registered to vote in the polling stations in Lok Ma Chau Spur Line, Lo Wu or Heung Yuen Wai Boundary Control Point; (b) Persons must be <i>bona fide</i> voters; and (c) Persons must proceed by using the most direct route to and from the polling stations.
