

SMALL UNMANNED AIRCRAFT ORDER

DESIGNATION OF RESTRICTED FLYING ZONE NOTICE

(Made under section 19(2)(b) of the Small Unmanned Aircraft Order (Chapter 448G))

By virtue of the authority under section 19(2)(b) of the Small Unmanned Aircraft Order, Chapter 448G, I hereby designate the Turf Track, Ambulance Track, Parade Ring, Grandstand, Pavilion Stand, Stable Bend Terrace, Forecourt, Members Stand I, Members Stand II and Member Stand III of the Happy Valley Racecourse (including the airspace above the area) as restricted flying zones for the purposes of section 18(1) of the said order.

The designation made in this notice shall come into effect from one hour before the scheduled time of the first race to 30 minutes after the scheduled time of the last race during the racing fixtures as follows:—

Pursuant to section 19 of the said Order, the Secretary for Security, the Commissioner of Police, and the Director-General of Civil Aviation may, by notice published in the *Gazette*, designate an area in Hong Kong (including the airspace above the area) as a restricted flying zone for the purposes of section 18(1) of the said order. Furthermore, relevant officials may publish a notice in the Electronic Portal for Small Unmanned Aircraft ('eSUA'), the designated information system, if the officials consider that it is necessary to publish the notice as soon as practicable, and it is impracticable in the circumstances to publish the notice in the *Gazette*.

The above-mentioned restricted flying zones are shown as indexed, inter alia, on the Drone Map deposited in the library at the Civil Aviation Department Headquarters, 1 Tung Fai Road, Hong Kong International Airport, Lantau, Hong Kong. Members of public may also refer to the Drone Map on eSUA (<https://esua.cad.gov.hk/web/>) for all restricted flying zones designated by virtue of section 19.
