ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON WANG MAU STREET AND WANG YUEN STREET, KOWLOON BAY

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 6.00 p.m. on 24 December 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane Wang Yuen Street from a point about 60 metres west of its junction with Wang Hoi Road to a point about 80 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Wang Yuen Street from its junction with Wang Mau Street to a point about 15 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Wang Mau Street from its junction with Wang Yuen Street to a point about 10 metres south of the same junction;
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of Wang Yuen Street from its junction with Wang Mau Street to a point about 5 metres east of the same junction; and
- (e) the eastern kerbside lane of Wang Mau Street from its junction with Wang Yuen Street to a point about 10 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
