

SPECIFICATION OF COLOUR SCHEME NOTICE

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 47(1) of the Road Traffic (Construction and Maintenance of Vehicles) Regulations, Chapter 374A, I hereby specify in the Schedule below, with effect from 22 December 2023, the colour, combination of colours or colour scheme with which the outside of public light buses and general taxis shall be painted.

SCHEDULE

<i>Item</i>	<i>Type of Vehicle</i>	<i>Colour Scheme</i>
1	Public light buses providing non-scheduled services	The body to be yellow (British Standard Colour 10C33 BS 4800); the roof panel including all parts above the windows on all sides to be red (British Standard Colour 538 BS 381C).
2	Public light buses providing scheduled services	The body to be yellow (British Standard Colour 10C33 BS 4800); the roof panel including all parts above the windows on all sides to be green (British Standard Colour 14E53 BS 4800).
3	General taxis licensed to be available for hire or to carry passengers (other than the general taxis referred to in items 4 and 5)	The roof panel including all support pillars to be silver; the lower portion of the body work including bonnet and boot panels to be red (British Standard Colour 538 BS 381C).
4	General taxis licensed to be available for hire or to carry passengers within the New Territories only (other than the general taxis referred to in item 5)	The roof panel including all support pillars to be white; the lower portion of the body work including bonnet and boot panels to be green (British Standard Colour 14E53 BS 4800).
5	General taxis licensed to be available for hire or to carry passengers on Lantau Island only	The roof panel including all support pillars to be white; the lower portion of the body work including bonnet and boot panels to be light blue (British Standard Colour 18E51 BS 4800).

The Specification of Colour Scheme Notice as gazetted in G.N. 988 of 1995 will be rescinded on 22 December 2023.
