

It is hereby notified that sealed tenders in duplicate are invited for **Contract No. SS K520—Redevelopment of Yuen Long Stadium (Programme No. 291RS)**.

The works include reprovisioning of an 11-a-side natural turf football pitch; reprovisioning of an 8-lane 400 metres-long synthetic athletic track and field facilities meeting the standards and requirements of the World Athletics; reprovisioning of west and east spectator stands with fixed covers and ancillary facilities accommodating a total of around 6 000 seats; provision of ancillary facilities to comply with the Asian Football Confederation (AFC) Stadium Regulations for the hosting of AFC Champions League and AFC Cup matches; re-provisioning of the existing car parking and bicycle spaces with additional public parking spaces to form a public vehicle park with 104 parking spaces; and beautification works for the public passage between the Yuen Long Stadium and the Yuen Long Swimming Pool. The total site area is around 30 000 square metres. The construction floor area is around 22 000 square metres. The contract is scheduled to commence in June 2022 and for completion in July 2025.

Tenders must be clearly marked with the tender reference and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer), addressed to the Chairman, Central Tender Board, and placed in the Government Secretariat Tender Box situated in the lobby of the Public Entrance on the Ground Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong before 12.00 noon on Friday, 11 February 2022. Tenders must be deposited in the tender box as specified in this tender notice ('Specified Tender Box') before the tender closing time. Late tenders or tenders not deposited in the Specified Tender Box will not be accepted.

If tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 or above is hoisted, or a black rainstorm warning signal or 'extreme conditions after super typhoons' announced by the Government is/are in force at any time between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on Friday, 11 February 2022, the tender closing time will be postponed to 12.00 noon on the first working day after the tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 is lowered, or the black rainstorm warning signal or the 'extreme conditions after super typhoons' announced by the Government has/have ceased to be in force. In case of blockage of the public access to the location of the Specified Tender Box at any time between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on Friday, 11 February 2022, the Government will announce extension of the tender closing time until further notice. Following removal of the blockage, the Government will announce the extended tender closing time as soon as practicable. Selective tendering is adopted. Contractors on the List of Approved Contractors for Public Works in Group C for Buildings Category or joint ventures with participation of local and/or overseas contractors with the lead participant or the major shareholder being on the above-mentioned approved list/category/group who also meet the following qualifications and other conditions for participation stipulated in the tender documents are invited to tender:—

- (1) the tenderer or in case of joint venture, the lead participant/major shareholder in a joint venture tenderer is a Group C contractor on the List of Approved Contractors for Public Works for Buildings Category as at the original date set for the close of tender or, if this has been extended, the extended date;
- (2) the tenderer must have completed at least one 'qualifying contract'. Qualifying contract means building contract in or outside Hong Kong with an adjusted original contract sum of not less than HK\$600 million, and with the substantial completion date within the past 10 years counting from and including the original date set for the close of tender (i.e. between 12 February 2012 and 11 February 2022); and
- (3) the tenderer or in case of joint venture, all participants/shareholders in a joint venture tenderer must have less than 5% performance reports rated as adverse based on the tenderer's past performance reports kept by Development Bureau (DEVB's record) in the

5-year period, which ends on the last Quarter End Date before the date being 2 months counting back from but exclusive of the original date set for the close of tender or, if this has been extended, the extended date (there are four Quarter End Dates in a year, namely the last day of February, May, August and November).

The detailed requirements on the tenderer's qualifications and those for joint ventures with participation of local and/or overseas contractors, if applicable, are stipulated in the tender documents.

Contractors not yet on the above-mentioned approved list/category/group may also submit a tender if they submit a request for participation together with a duly completed application for inclusion in the above-mentioned approved list/category/group by 18 January 2022 to Chief Quantity Surveyor/2 of Quantity Surveying Branch, Architectural Services Department, 33rd Floor, Queensway Government Offices, 66 Queensway, Hong Kong, meet the qualifications and conditions for participation, and the application for inclusion is duly approved on or before the tender closing date. A charge will be levied for delivery of tender documents where the delivery of tender documents is requested by a tenderer. A written request must be made.
