

## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

## RESTRICTED ZONES IN TAI WAI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 30 December 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Tai Po Road—Tai Wai from a point about 18 metres west of its junction with Tai Wai Road to a point about 57 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Tai Wai Road from its junction with Tai Po Road—Tai Wai to a point about 21 metres south of the same junction;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Tai Wai Road from its junction with Tai Po Road—Tai Wai to a point about 46 metres south of the same junction; and
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of Tai Po Road—Sha Tin Heights from a point about 61 metres west of its junction with the vehicular ingress to Sha Tin Heights to a point about 119 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
