

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN TO KWA WAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 6.00 a.m. on 31 December 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of To Kwa Wan Road northbound from a point about 45 metres south to its junction with Chi Kiang Street to a point about 45 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of To Kwa Wan Road southbound from a point about 40 metres north to its junction with Chi Kiang Street to a point about 35 metres south of the same junction;
- (c) the northern kerbside lane of Chi Kiang Street eastbound from a point about 25 metres west to its junction with To Kwa Wan Road to a point about 20 metres east of the same junction; and
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of Chi Kiang Street eastbound from a point about 25 metres west to its junction with To Kwa Wan Road to a point about 35 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
