ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE (Chapter 374)

TEMPORARY SPEED LIMIT ON TOLO HIGHWAY AND TAI PO ROAD—SHA TIN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under section 40(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Ordinance, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 11.00 p.m. to 6.00 a.m. of the following day daily from 4 January 2022 to 6 January 2022, the following road sections will be temporarily subject to a speed limit of 80 kilometres per hour:—

- (a) the section of Tolo Highway northbound from a point about 60 metres north of its junction with Tai Po Road—Sha Tin to a point about 70 metres north of Chak Cheung Street;
- (b) the section of the slip road leading from Tai Po Road—Sha Tin to Tolo Highway northbound from its junction with Tolo Highway to a point about 220 metres south of the same junction;
- (c) the section of Tolo Highway southbound from a point about 90 metres south of its junction with Tate's Cairn Highway to its junction with Tai Po Road—Sha Tin;
- (d) the section of Sui Cheung Street southbound from its junction with Tolo Highway to a point about 40 metres north of the same junction; and
- (e) the section of Tai Po Road—Sha Tin southbound from its junction with Tolo Highway to a point about 75 metres south of the slip road leading from Sha Tin Racecourse Bus Terminus to Tai Po Road—Sha Tin.

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected on site to guide motorists.

At the same time, the existing speed limit of 100 kilometres per hour on the above road sections will be temporarily rescinded.
