ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374 Sub. Leg. G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON LOK TIN STREET AND ON LOK MUN STREET. FANLING

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374 sub. leg. G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 31 December 2021, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the whole western kerbside lane of Lok Tin Street from its junction with Sha Tau Kok Road—Lung Yeuk Tau to its junction with On Lok Mun Street;
- (b) the whole eastern kerbside lane of Lok Tin Street from its junction with Sha Tau Kok Road—Lung Yeuk Tau to its junction with On Lok Mun Street;
- (c) the section of northern kerbside lane of On Lok Mun Street from a point about 38 metres west of its junction with Lok Tin Street to a point about 11 metres east of the same junction; and
- (d) the section of southern kerbside lane of On Lok Mun Street from a point about 38 metres west of its junction with Lok Tin Street to a point about 33 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
