ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONE IN TUNG CHEONG STREET, TAI PO

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 6.01 p.m. on 31 December 2021 to 6.00 p.m. on 19 March 2022, the eastern kerbside lane of Tung Cheong Street from a point about 35 metres north of its eastern junction with Plover Cove Road eastbound to a point about 50 metres north of the same junction will continue to be temporarily designated as a restricted zone 24 hours daily.

Within the restricted zone, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zone will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs or road markings.
