## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

## RESTRICTED ZONES IN HAI TAN STREET AND PEI HO STREET, SHAM SHUI PO

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 11 February 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Pei Ho Street from its junction with Hai Tan Street to a point about 20 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Pei Ho Street from its junction with Hai Tan Street to a point about 20 metres north of the same junction;
- (c) the northern kerbside lane of Hai Tan Street from its junction with Pei Ho Street to a point about 10 metres west of the same junction;
- (d) the northern kerbside lane of Hai Tan Street from its junction with Pei Ho Street to a point about 15 metres east of the same junction; and
- (e) the southern kerbside lane of Hai Tan Street from a point about 10 metres west of the junction with Pei Ho Street to a point about 25 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
