

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN UN CHAU STREET
AND KWEILIN STREET, SHAM SHUI PO

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 17 February 2023, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Un Chau Street from its junction with Kweilin Street to a point about 25 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Un Chau Street from its junction with Kweilin Street to a point about 8 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Kweilin Street from a point about 9 metres north of its junction with Un Chau Street to a point about 7 metres south of the same junction; and
- (d) the eastern kerbside lane of Kweilin Street from a point about 9 metres north of its junction with Un Chau Street to a point about 12 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
