ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE (Chapter 374)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY SPEED LIMIT ON KAI FUK ROAD, KOWLOON BAY

In exercise of the powers vested in me under section 40(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Ordinance, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 6.00 p.m. on 20 February 2024 to 6.00 p.m. on 15 June 2024, the following road sections will continue to be temporarily subject to a speed limit of 50 kilometres per hour:—

- (a) the section of Kai Fuk Road westbound from a point about 500 metres east of its junction with Kai Cheung Road slip road westbound to a point about 20 metres east of the entrance of Kai Tak Tunnel; and
- (b) the section of Kai Fuk Road eastbound from a point about 100 metres east of the exit of Kai Tak Tunnel to a point about 430 metres east of the abovementioned starting point.

Appropriate traffic signs have been erected on site to guide motorists.

At the same time, the existing speed limit of 70 kilometres per hour on the above road sections will continue to be temporarily rescinded.
