

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN LAI CHI KOK ROAD, CHEUNG SHA WAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 25 February 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Lai Chi Kok Road westbound from a point about 30 metres east of its junction with Lai Chi Kok Road *cul-de-sac* (near Sham Mong Road Substation) to a point about 135 metres west of the same junction; and
- (b) the section of Lai Chi Kok Road *cul-de-sac* (near Sham Mong Road Substation) from its junction with Lai Chi Kok Road westbound to a point about 25 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road section will be rescinded.
