ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON PAK WO ROAD AND SO KWUN PO ROAD, SHEUNG SHUI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 24 February 2023, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Pak Wo Road from a point about 50 metres west of its junction with Ching Hiu Road to a point about 20 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Pak Wo Road from a point about 40 metres west of its junction with So Kwun Po Road to a point about 30 metres east of the same junction;
- (c) the southern kerbside lane of Pak Wo Road from a point about 30 metres west of its junction with So Kwun Po Road to a point about 20 metres east of the same junction;
- (d) the eastern kerbside lane of So Kwun Po Road from its junction with Pak Wo Road to a point about 60 metres north of the same junction; and
- (e) the western kerbside lane of So Kwun Po Road from its junction with Pak Wo Road to a point about 30 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones of the above road sections will be rescinded.
