PUBLIC BUS SERVICES ORDINANCE (Chapter 230)

SCALE OF FARES NOTICE CITYBUS LIMITED

(FRANCHISE FOR HONG KONG ISLAND AND CROSS HARBOUR ROUTES)

The concessionary fare for passengers aged between 60 and 64 offered by Citybus Limited (Franchise for Hong Kong Island and Cross Harbour Routes) (specified in paragraph 3(c) in Part II of the Schedule to G.N. 1763 of 2021) will end on 26 February 2022. The following is published for general information:—

- (i) Part I of the Schedule: the scale of fares as determined by the Chief Executive in Council pursuant to section 13(1)(a) of the Public Bus Services Ordinance (Chapter 230) ('the Ordinance') which took effect from 4 April 2021, together with the baggage and goods charges;
- (ii) Part II of the Schedule: the concessionary fares as permitted by the Commissioner for Transport pursuant to section 13(4)(b) of the Ordinance with effect from 27 February 2022; and
- (iii) Part III of the Schedule: the maximum rate of increase which may be permitted by the Commissioner for Transport under section 13(3) of the Ordinance.

PART I

Adult Fares

(A) Subject to paragraph 1(B), the adult single fare that Citybus Limited shall charge on each specified route or group of specified routes shall be the amount stipulated in the Third Column of the fare scale below.

- (B) In the case where the journey distance of an express route is shorter than that of an existing non-express route serving broadly the same destinations, the journey distance of the nonexpress route shall be adopted for the purpose of determining the fare of the express route.
- 2. Baggage and Goods Charges
 - (a) On any route, a passenger may carry free of charge a package or packages of a total weight not exceeding 5 kilograms and a total volume not exceeding 0.1 cubic metre so long as such package or packages may be safely and conveniently carried.
 - (b) No additional charge shall be made in respect of one bamboo or wooden pole not exceeding 60 millimetres in diameter and 1.5 metres in length.
 - (c) No passenger shall carry more than 5 kilograms of fresh fish or dried fish.

PART II

3. Concessionary Fares

- (a) Children below the age of 12 years shall be charged on every service one half of the adult single fare for any journey calculated to the nearest ten cents above.
- (b) Children below the age of 4 years, if accompanied by an adult and not occupying a seat, shall be carried free of charge. Not more than two children shall be carried free of charge by any one adult.
- (c) Passengers aged 65 or above shall be charged on every service, except Recreation Services, one half of the adult single fare for any journey calculated to the nearest ten cents above.

PART III

- 4. The maximum rate of increase is 50% of the scale of fares specified in Part I.
- 5. The scale of fares gazetted in the Schedule to G.N. 1763 of 2021 is hereby superseded.
