

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

TEMPORARY PROHIBITED ZONE ON QUEEN'S ROAD WEST,
WESTERN DISTRICT

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 8.00 a.m. on 3 March 2023 to 6.00 p.m. on 3 June 2023, the following road sections will be temporarily designated as prohibited zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Queen's Road West from a point about 45 metres west of its junction with Hill Road to a point about 80 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Queen's Road West from its junction with Hill Road to a point about 90 metres east of the same junction; and
- (c) the southern kerbside lane of Queen's Road West from a point about 30 metres east of its junction with Hill Road to a point about 70 metres east of the same junction.

Drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from driving vehicles into the above prohibited zones.

The extent of the prohibited zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs.
