

CORRIGENDUM

With reference to the Government Notice No. 795 on Gazette Extraordinary No. 292 Vol. 26 published on 24 August 2022 and the Government Notice No. 803 on Gazette Extraordinary No. 294 Vol. 26 published on 26 August 2022, it is hereby notified that the measure “subject to note 5 of the notice, persons responsible for/managers of premises that are required to use the “QR Code Verification Scanner” shall use the updated version of scanner (version 4.4.0 or above) to scan the COVID-19 Vaccination Record or Vaccination Medical Exemption Certificate to identify customers/users/visitors entering the premises are not persons with Red Code, and ensure that the relevant devices are connected to the Internet (either through WiFi or data cards) during the operating hours of the premises (see notes 3 and 4 of the notice); reasonably practicable arrangements must also be made to ensure that staff members involved in the operation of the business on the premises with the “Red Code” must not enter the premises” under Part (N)(7) in Annex of the notice should be amended to read “subject to note 5 of the notice, visual inspection of the vaccine pass QR code presented by customers/users/visitors (if any) must be carried out to ensure that customers/users/visitors entering the premises are not holding the “Red Code” (see notes 3 and 4 of the notice); reasonably practicable arrangements must also be made to ensure that staff members involved in the operation of the business on the premises with the “Red Code” must not enter the premises”.

With reference to the Government Notice No. 828 on Gazette Extraordinary No. 307 Vol. 26 published on 7 September 2022, it is hereby notified that the measure “subject to note 5 of the notice, must use the updated version of scanner (version 4.4.0 or above) to scan the COVID-19 Vaccination Record or Vaccination Medical Exemption Certificate to identify customers/users/visitors entering the premises are not persons with Red Code, and ensure that the relevant device(s) is/are connected to the Internet (either through WiFi or data cards) during the operating hours of the premises (see notes 3 and 4 of the notice); reasonably practicable arrangements must also be made to ensure that staff members involved in the operation of the business on the premises with the “Red Code” must not enter the premises” under Part (N)(7) in Annex of the notice should be amended to read “subject to note 5 of the notice, visual inspection of the vaccine pass QR code presented by customers/users/visitors (if any) must be carried out to ensure that customers/users/visitors entering the premises are not holding the “Red Code” (see notes 3 and 4 of the notice); reasonably practicable arrangements must also be made to ensure that staff members involved in the operation of the business on the premises with the “Red Code” must not enter the premises”.
