## COMPULSORY QUARANTINE OF CERTAIN PERSONS ARRIVING AT HONG KONG REGULATION

I hereby exercise the power conferred by section 12 of the Compulsory Quarantine of Certain Persons Arriving at Hong Kong Regulation (Chapter 599 sub. leg. C) (*the Regulation*) to specify, with effect from 6.00 a.m. on 26 September 2022, for the purposes of section 3 of the Regulation:—

- 1. the Mainland, Macao and Taiwan as Category 2 specified places in China; and
- 2. conditions set out in the Annex for Category 2 specified places in China.

G.N. (E.) 651 of 2021 will be suspended upon the commencement of the above specifications at 6.00 a.m. on 26 September 2022.

## CONDITIONS SPECIFIED FOR CATEGORY 2 SPECIFIED PLACES IN CHINA—THE MAINLAND, MACAO AND TAIWAN

Conditions specified pursuant to section 12(2) of the Regulation:—

- (1) Other than a person who is designated or falls within a category of persons designated under section 4(1) of the Regulation or the Compulsory Quarantine of Persons Arriving at Hong Kong from Foreign Places Regulation (Chapter 599 sub. leg. E):—
  - (a) The person declares his or her travel history and health conditions, and provides his or her personal particulars and other information required to be provided (in an electronic form or physical form specified by the Director of Health) to an authorised officer by presenting the filled-in form to a person acting under the direction of an authorised officer upon arrival at Hong Kong.
