(Chapter 547)

(Section 4 of Schedule 4A to the Ordinance)

**INSPECTION OF THE DISTRICT COMMITTEES CONSTITUENCIES  
REGISTER FOR THE 2023 DISTRICT COUNCIL ORDINARY ELECTION**

Pursuant to section 4 of Schedule 4A to the District Councils Ordinance (Cap. 547) (hereinafter referred to as “the Ordinance”), it is hereby notified that a copy of the District Committees Constituencies Register is available for inspection by specified persons<sup>1</sup> from 9 October 2023 onwards<sup>2</sup> during ordinary business hours, that is, Monday to Friday (other than a general holiday) from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. at the following places —

- (a) Registration and Electoral Office: 8<sup>th</sup> Floor, Treasury Building, 3 Tonkin Street West, Cheung Sha Wan, Kowloon; and
- (b) Registration and Electoral Office: 13<sup>th</sup> Floor, Kowloonbay International Trade and Exhibition Centre, 1 Trademart Drive, Kowloon Bay, Kowloon.

<sup>1</sup> Pursuant to section 5(10) of Schedule 4A to the Ordinance, *specified person* (指明的人) means —

- (a) a person who is a subscriber to the Government News and Media Information System maintained by the Director of Information Services;
- (b) a body or organization that is incorporated, or is registered or exempt from registration, under any law of Hong Kong and—
  - (i) was provided an extract under section 6 of Schedule 4A for a purpose related to a previous election;
  - (ii) was represented by a validly nominated candidate at a previous election; or
  - (iii) has publicly declared an intention to arrange for any person (including a person yet to be specified) to stand as a candidate at a coming election; or
- (c) a person who is a validly nominated candidate for a District Committees constituency at a coming election.

<sup>2</sup> Pursuant to section 4(3) of Schedule 4A to the Ordinance, the District Committees constituencies register takes effect on the date of publication of the notice under section 4(1) in relation to the register and continues to have effect until the conclusion of the election.
