PUBLIC ORDER ORDINANCE (Chapter 245)

CLOSED AREA—PERMISSION TO ENTER

Pursuant to section 38A(1) of the Public Order Ordinance and without prejudice to the provisions of any other Ordinance, persons within the category specified in the second column of the below Schedule are, for the purposes of the Public Order Ordinance, permitted to enter or leave the Frontier Closed Area at Boundary Patrol Road (a specified section between lamp post number 594 and 597) connected to Lok Ma Chau Loop as specified in the second column, during the dates and times specified in the third column of the Schedule, subject to the conditions specified in the fourth column of the Schedule.

In this notice 'the Frontier Closed Area' refers to the area specified in the Schedule to the Frontier Closed Area Order.
