

It is hereby notified that sealed tenders in duplicate are invited for **nominated sub-contract to Contract No. SS G514—Electrical and Fire Service Installations for the Construction of Two 30-classroom Primary Schools at Queen's Hill, Fanling (Programme No. 360EP and 361EP).**

The works of the Nominated Sub-contract include the design, supply, installation, testing and commissioning of electrical installation and fire service installation for the construction of two 30-classroom primary schools at Queen's Hill, Fanling. The main contract is scheduled to commence in April 2019 and for completion in March 2021.

Tenders must be clearly marked with the tender reference and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer), addressed to the Chairman, Public Works Tender Board, and placed in the Public Works Tender Box situated in Room 4128f on the 41st Floor of the Queensway Government Offices, 66 Queensway, Hong Kong before 12.00 noon on Friday, 26 April 2019. Tenders must be deposited in the tender box as specified in this tender notice ('Specified Tender Box') before the tender closing time. Late tenders and tenders not deposited in the Specified Tender Box will not be accepted.

If a black rainstorm warning signal or tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 or above is in force at any time between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on Friday, 26 April 2019, the tender closing time will be postponed to 12.00 noon on the first working day after the black rainstorm warning signal has ceased to be in effect or the tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 has been replaced by a lower signal.
