Protection of Endangered Species of Animals and Plants Ordinance (Amendment of Schedules 1 and 3) Order 2021

(Made by the Secretary for the Environment under section 48 of the Protection of Endangered Species of Animals and Plants Ordinance (Cap. 586))

1. Commencement

This Order comes into operation on 30 April 2021.

2. Protection of Endangered Species of Animals and Plants Ordinance amended

The Protection of Endangered Species of Animals and Plants Ordinance (Cap. 586) is amended as set out in sections 3 and 4.



Explanatory Note

The main purpose of this Order is to amend Schedules 1 and 3 to the Protection of Endangered Species of Animals and Plants Ordinance (Cap. 586) (*Ordinance*) to give effect to—

- (a) the changes made in August 2019 to the listings of endangered species in Appendices I and II to the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (*Convention*);
- (b) the changes made since the last amendment of the Ordinance in 2018 to the listings of endangered species in Appendix III to the Convention;
- (c) the changes made in August 2019 to the resolutions adopted by the Conference of the Parties to the Convention; and
- (d) the technical amendments arising from the updates in nomenclature, rectification to nomenclature and provision of common names to species names.
