**INSPECTION OF THE 2021 SUBSECTOR FINAL REGISTER**

Pursuant to section 38 of the Electoral Affairs Commission (Registration) (Electors for Legislative Council Functional Constituencies) (Voters for Election Committee Subsectors) (Members of Election Committee) Regulation (Cap. 541B), the judgment handed down by the Court of Appeal on 21 May 2020 and the order made at the hearing on 27 May 2020 [Case no. CACV 73/2020] (if applicable)<sup>1</sup>, it is hereby notified that a copy of the subsector final register is available for inspection by validly nominated candidates, members of press and political parties for a purpose related to the election from 5 August 2021 onwards during ordinary business hours (from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.) from Monday to Friday (other than a general holiday) at the following places –

- (a) Registration and Electoral Office: 10<sup>th</sup> Floor, Harbour Centre, 25 Harbour Road, Wan Chai, Hong Kong; and
- (b) Registration and Electoral Office: 13<sup>th</sup> Floor, Kowloonbay International Trade and Exhibition Centre, 1 Trademart Drive, Kowloon Bay, Kowloon.

The parts of the subsector final register containing the names and principal residential addresses of individual voters will only be provided for inspection by validly nominated candidates, members of press and political parties, while the relevant parts containing the registered particulars of corporate voters will be provided for inspection by members of the public.
