

It is hereby notified that sealed tenders in duplicate are invited for **Contract No. ED/2020/03, Trunk Road T2—Traffic Control and Surveillance System and Associated Works (Public Works Programme Item No. 7785TH)**. The works include design, supply, delivery, installation, testing and commissioning of the traffic control and surveillance system (TCSS) for the Trunk Road T2 and associated works and integration of Trunk Road T2 TCSS with the central system of the Tseung Kwan O—Lam Tin Tunnel (TKO-LTT) TCSS. The works are scheduled to commence in Q1 2022 and will take about 36 months to complete.

Tenders must be clearly marked with the tender reference and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer) addressed to the Chairman, Public Works Tender Board, and placed in the Public Works Tender Box situated in Room 503, 5th Floor, Low Block, Queensway Government Offices, 66 Queensway, Hong Kong, before 12.00 noon on Friday, 29 October 2021. Tenders must be deposited in the tender box as specified in this tender notice ('Specified Tender Box') before the tender closing time. Late tenders and tenders not deposited in the Specified Tender Box will not be accepted. If tropical cyclone signal No. 8 or above is hoisted, or a black rainstorm warning signal or 'extreme conditions after super typhoons' announced by the Government is/are in force at any time between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on Friday, 29 October 2021, the tender closing time will be postponed to 12.00 noon on the first working day after the tropical cyclone signal No. 8 is lowered, or the black rainstorm warning signal or the 'extreme conditions after super typhoons' announced by the Government has/have ceased to be in force. In case of blockage of the public access to the location of the Specified Tender Box at any time between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on Friday, 29 October 2021, the Government will announce extension of the tender closing time until further notice. Following removal of the blockage, the Government will announce the extended tender closing time as soon as practicable. Open tendering is adopted. All interested contractors who also meet the following requirement are invited to tender:—

- (i) The tenderer, or the participants/ shareholders collectively in case of a joint venture tenderer, has completed at least one construction contract of TCSS at road/ tunnel/ viaduct, with an adjusted contract value of not less than HK\$25 million, in or outside Hong Kong, within the past 15 years counting from and including the original date set for the close of tender. The adjusted contract value shall be the awarded contract sum being adjusted to current price level as stipulated in the tender documents.
- (ii) The tender shall comply with the minimum conditions as set out in the tender documents.

This tender is covered by the Agreement on Government Procurement of the World Trade Organization and will not involve electronic auction. This notice also serves as a summary notice required under the Agreement on Government Procurement of the World Trade Organization.

A charge will be levied for delivery of tender documents where the delivery of tender documents is requested by a tenderer. A written request must be made.

The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region does not bind itself to accept any tender irrespective of whether the tender is the lowest bid or where the assessment of tenders is based on a marking scheme or formula approach, the tender with the highest overall score.
